Haven's first elections have come to an end, and the first council has been formed. They are to meet regularly over the next weeks to establish policy in accordance with their platforms and to iron out any differences in their thinking. We may soon see great change in Haven's policy.

Let us dive into those we have elected and the policies we can expect to see in the coming months.

Paula Longhorn, the Master of Law, will be establishing rules for the selection of jury members and begin the long process of outlining guidelines for crimes that the first jury members can use to guide their verdicts. Then begins the process of handling any crimes that are brought before the courts and setting precedent. (50%, 2/4 votes)

Barbara Lunala, the Master of Commerce, will be setting restrictions on the Council's involvement with the

economy of Haven, as well as establishing only the most necessary taxes to keep Haven's treasury stocked enough to undertake development projects.

(50%, 3/6 votes)

Logan Asker, the Master of Defense, will be one council member who will likely make very few changes – already the captain of the Perchguard, Logan will be formalizing positions and integrating the Windrunners and Perchguard a little more tightly together.

(80%, 4/5 votes)

Kodenn Koleke, the Master of Agriculture, will be beginning a thorough survey of Haven's resource gathering professions and Haven's needs in order to establish proper limits, before turning his attention to establishing his farmer's union. (75%, 3/4 votes)

Herbert Twinfeather, the Master of Development, will be focused on finalizing Haven's walls before turning his attention to a library and developing outposts – not least of all Fort Terakka, as well as appointing overseers for each region. (80%, 4/5 votes)

Oleg Koloss, the Master of External Relations, will likely begin by formalizing relations with the kuo-toa, aligning

Haven with one of the kuo-toa factions or seeking to unite them in some way. He will likely also be looking towards better understanding the lizardfolk.

(50%, 1/2 votes)

Farley Sunfallow, the Master of Arcana, will likely begin with finding a temporary place to begin a repository of arcane knowledge before Twinfeather's library is built. From there, expect to see a research topic be chosen to guide Haven's first arcane endeavours.
